➤ Main Highlights of the Traffic Awareness Program:

- On 17/01/2025, the Deputy Commissioner of Police (Traffic) IPS Pooja Yadav Madam and her team including DCP Sir, Khaped Sir (RTO Rajkot) and Saha Sir addressed the group of students and faculties at AVPTI Rajkot. The primary focus of the speech was to raise awareness about road safety and responsible behaviour while using public roads.
- Key points from the speech included:
- Importance of Road Safety: The Deputy Commissioner of Police and her team emphasized the critical role students play in promoting safe driving habits and pedestrian awareness. He highlighted statistics on road accidents involving young people.
- **Traffic Rules and Regulations:** The importance of adhering to traffic rules, such as wearing seat belts, using helmets, and following speed limits, was stressed. The Deputy Commissioner encouraged students to familiarize themselves with local traffic laws.

- **Peer Influence:** They discussed the impact of peer behaviour on road safety. He urged students to be responsible role models for their friends and family.
- Consequences of Negligence: Real-life examples of accidents resulting from reckless driving and distracted behaviours were shared to underline the serious consequences of neglecting road safety.
- **Community Involvement:** The Deputy Commissioner called for active participation from students in community initiatives aimed at promoting road safety, such as awareness campaigns and volunteering for local traffic control programs.
- **Q&A Session:** The speech concluded with a question-and-answer segment, where students expressed their concerns and offered suggestions, fostering an engaging dialogue on traffic safety issues.

The event was well-received, with students and faculties expressing appreciation for the informative session, indicating a heightened awareness of road safety responsibilities.
